





Luggage

Money

- Tanzanian Shilling
- U.S. Dollars are widely excepted
- Cash bring U.S. Dollars
- ATMs near hotels in Zanzibar and Arusha
- Credit cards Visa and MasterCard
- Do not bring Travellers Cheques



Tipping

- Safari guides: \$20 per guide, per day
- Other guides:
 - Ng'iresi Village, \$5 per person
 - Half-day tours: \$3 per person
- Meals:
 - Group meals: Small tip on the table
 - Other meals: 10%-15%
- Porter: \$1-\$2 per bag
- Some hotels/lodges have a communal tip jar



Health and Safety

- Vaccinations and anti-malarial meds
- Jet lag
- Bugs
- Dust
- Altitude
- Toilets
- Security
- Street touts



Food and Water

• Food:

- Food at hotels and restaurants is safe
- Zanzibar two meals on your own
- Street food: proceed with caution
- Avoid salads and fruits without a peel

• Water:

- Bottled water
 - Drinking and brushing teeth
- Ice ask if purified or boiled first
- Bathing don't open your mouth

Arusha	70	48	1.3
Tarangire	77	57	0.2
Serengeti	77	57	1.2
Ngorongoro	70	54	0.5

• Eastern Africa Time (EAT) zone - 7 hours ahead of MI

• Voltage is 220V-240V (U.S. is 120V)

• Dual voltage items – just need type D and G adapters

• If not dual voltage, need a converter too

• Generators



Communication

- Cell phones
 - Decent reception on Zanzibar and in Arusha
 - Check with your provider about international plans
- Internet
 - Wifi is available in many locations
 - Some hotels have guest computers



Culture

- Hakuna Matata
- Handouts
- Respect
 - Do not wear lots of jewelry or carry expensive electronic equipment out in the open
 - Don't leave expensive items out in your hotel room



Language

- English is widely spoken
- Swahili
 - Jambo
 - Habari?
 - Nzuri
 - Karibu
 - Asante sana
 - Kahawa
 - Simba, Tembo, Duma, Chui, Kiboko, Twiga

- Be very, very quiet
- Look around

- Check high and low
- Dung



Souvenirs

• Always bargain in a market or small shop

• You are expected to bargain

• Offer ½ price – good starting point

• Stay positive and polite, and have fun!

- If it's not working out, try walking away
- Keep exchange rate in perspective
- Upscale shops with prices marked probably not worth bargaining



Photography

• Lots of opportunities for wildlife photos

• Zoom is helpful, but not necessary

• Don't get too close

• Ask permission before photographing people

• Children along the road

• No pics at airport or other areas with security
